

## Girls and Dating Violence

Levy, B. (1984). *Skills for violence-free relationships: Curriculum for young people ages 13-18*. Santa Monica, CA: Southern California Coalition on Battered Women.

This book is a curriculum designed to teach teenagers what battering is, why it happens, how to deal with it and how to keep it from relationships. This educational guide includes sections on attitudes toward violence and toward women, recognizing stereotypes and conflict resolution. Also includes printed handouts for instructional purposes. 88 pp.

Levy, B. (Ed.). (1991). *Dating violence: Young women in danger*. Seattle: The Seal Press.

An anthology of writings on the subject of dating violence, including context, intervention strategies and educational and prevention projects. In addition, first part of book includes stories from teens and parents describing abusive dating relationships. Index, contributors' notes, resources of educational curriculums, manuals, films and videos, and references. 315 pp.

Levy, B. (1993). *In love & in danger: A teen's guide to breaking free of abusive relationships*. Seattle: Seal Press.

An excellent book aimed toward answering teen's questions and attitudes regarding dating violence. Talks toward those who are abusive as well as those being abused. Good discussions about different types of relationships with examples. Selected titles list from publisher. 107 pp.

Levy, B. & Giggans, P.O. (1995). *What parents need to know about dating violence*. Seattle: Seal Press.

According to the authors, dating violence touches the lives of one out of every four high-school and college-age youth. Through real-life examples, the authors share advice to parents who are struggling with this issue. 170pp
